**Il Paradiso di Frassina  
Brunello di Montalcino 2004** **\$44.99/\$485.00**

This has a deep red color with aromas of red berries, vanilla, and spice. Lively acids nicely frame the black cherry and redcurrant flavors. Lovely, fine-grained, tannins are smooth on the palate providing good balance and leading to a moderately long finish.

**Colosi Nero d'Avola 2008** **\$15.99/\$172.00**

Colosi's 2008 Nero d'Avola is a fresh, vinous offering loaded with perfumed red fruit. Ideally the wine needs a few months to recover from its recent bottling, as the full range of aromas and flavors remains rather muted at this stage. This soft, supple Nero d'Avola offers terrific quality for the money. Anticipated maturity: 2009-2012. The Wine Advocate, 89 points



**Cantele Salice Salentino Riserva 2004** **\$11.99/\$129.00**

**BEST BUY!** - The aromas of bacon fat and smoke dominate the notes of rose and plum when this is first poured. A blend of negroamaro (85 percent) and malvasia nera (15), it gains depth with air, melding umami richness with vibrant acidity. Decant a bottle for braised boar. Wine & Spirits, 92 points

**Pecchenino Dolcetto  
di Dogliani San Luigi 2007** **\$19.99/\$215.00**

Dolcetto is the everyday drinking wine of the people of Piedmont, Italy. This bottling shows ripe black cherry and licorice aromas and flavors. It is full-bodied with a silky texture and a flavorful finish. "Brothers Orlando and Attilio Pecchenino run this small property in Dogliani, where they make some of the most powerful, intense Dolcetto readers are likely to come across." Antonio Galloni of the Wine Advocate.

**Abbazia di Novacella Kerner 2007** **\$19.99/\$215.00**

Abbazia di Novacella is the northernmost winery in Italy, lying right at the foot of the Dolomites. A hybrid out of Riesling and Trollinger, Kerner yields a delicately perfumed but medium-bodied wine of great finesse with elegant fruit flavors and stony, mineral notes. Perfect as an aperitif or to accompany appetizers and shellfish based dishes.

**Rocca di Frassinello  
Poggio Alla Guardia 2006** **\$24.99/\$269.00**

This is a blend of 15% Sangiovese, 45% Merlot, and 40% Cabernet Sauvignon. Fermented and aged in stainless steel, it has a dark ruby garnet color with spicy and meaty dark fruit aromas. On the palate it is silky smooth and exhibits lovely blueberry and blackberry fruit flavors with notes of clove and loam. It has excellent structure, good acidity, and grip on the finish.

**Mionetto Sergio Prosecco N.V.** **\$15.99/\$191.88**

A couple of old grape varieties unique to the region are blended in - 70% Prosecco and a 30% mix of Verdiso, Bianchetta, and Chardonnay. It has a pronounced yeastiness in the aroma along with pear and melon notes, along with a medium-full mouth feel and lovely acidity in the off-dry finish. This is a great aperitif and has enough character to accompany most pasta in cream sauce as well as shellfish. www.wineoverspage.com, 4 stars



**Mionetto Moscato Dolce N.V.** **\$13.99/\$151.00**

This sparkling wine is fresh and crisp with a citrus bouquet. After a delicate pressing of the grapes it is fermented with the Charmat method in large pressure-sealed stainless steel vats, creating a bright golden straw yellow Moscato. It is crisp on the palate with flavors reminiscent of peaches and honey that are enhanced by the intense yet fine bubbles.

**Pertinace Barbera d'Alba 2007** **\$17.99/\$194.00**

The purple color shows good intensity, while the fruity, vinous bouquet is very expansive and persistent. On the palate the flavors are round with notes of spice, black fruits, and rich earth.

**Pertinace Barbaresco 2004** **\$39.99/\$431.00**

The 2004 Barbaresco Pertinace is a silky-textured, elegant wine with pretty notes of grilled herbs, tar, licorice, menthol and dark fruit. Medium in body, it offers outstanding balance and an accessible, engaging personality. Anticipated maturity: 2008-2016. The Wine Advocate, 90 points

**Alois Lageder Pinot Grigio 2008** **\$17.99/\$194.00**

This shows complex fruit flavors with an intense but soft texture balanced by the grape's hallmark crispness. "While Lageder's single-vineyard pinot biancos and chardonnays have deservedly impressive reputations, a more humble variety like pinot grigio demonstrates just how masterful Lageder truly is." **Badia a Coltibuono Chianti Classico 2007** **\$17.99/\$194.00**

This real Chianti Classico immediately brings to mind the elegant beauty of Tuscany. The wine is streamlined and tight yet generous in its portrayal of wild berries, white almonds, and delicate spice. Fresh and long-lasting, it would pair with hand-kneaded gnocchi with spinach and ricotta cheese. The Wine Enthusiast, 88 points

**Tenuta Sant'Antonio Scaia Rossa 2007 \$12.99/\$140.00**



Aged in stainless steel, this 100% Corvina has a ruby red color with purple hues. The nose hints of red rose, violet, and red/black berries. On the palate it is fruity with notes of red and black cherry, plum, and black-berry. It is well-balanced and intense and with good body and mouth feel.

**Inama Soave Classico 2007 \$14.99/\$161.00**

The light yellow color leads to an elegant nose of sweet meadow flowers like Camomile, Elder, and Iris. It is more than pleasant on the palate with a finish of sweet almond and subtle mineral. It is made from 100% Garganega grapes that grow in the 30 year old vineyard.

**Chianti Scopetani Terre di Toscana Riserva 2005 \$13.99/\$151.00**

This has an intense ruby-red color with violet highlights. It has a fruity nose of violet and black cherry. The flavors are rich with soft tannins, a good body, and long finish.

**Terre de Trinci Rosso di Montefalco 2004 \$12.99/\$140.00**

Terre de Trinci is a cooperative made up of small producers in Umbria. A blend of Sangiovese and Sagrantino, this wine has a medium body with ripe berries and toast in the bouquet and taste. There is good balance between tannins and fruit making this a great food wine, but also easy to drink on its own.

**Veste Porpora Tenuta Ronci di Nepi 2006 \$13.99/\$151.00**



This is a brilliant ruby red color with intense aromas that start with hints of black cherry and plum followed by toasted wood, vanilla, blue-berry, and tobacco. The mouth feel has a slightly tannic attack but is balanced by alcohol, good body, and intense flavors. The finish is persistent with flavors of plum and black cherry.

**Querceto Sangiovese di Toscana Super Tuscan 2004 \$19.99/\$215.00**

This estate bottled wine shows a great deal of classic Sangiovese characteristics. The aromas are of dried cherry fruit and clean garden earth with a touch of vanilla and smoke from aging 6 months in French oak barriques. In the mouth it has lively acidity and substantial tannins that balance the dark fruit and spicy flavors.

**Olivier Leflaive Bourgogne Blanc 2007 \$19.99/\$215.00**

A fresh, airy and really quite pretty nose of earth, floral and a lemon peel note merges into delicious, energetic and punchy flavors that are not especially dense but offer good cut and persistence on the dry finish where the citrus character resurfaces. More than respectable quality. Burghound, 86 points

**Olivier Leflaive Bourgogne Pinot Noir Cuvée Margot 2006 \$24.99/\$269.00**

Garnet hue. Quite compact aromas of red cherry and forest floor. Sweet, fresh and pretty flavors of strawberry and raspberry are as approachable as a serious Pinot can be. Tingly finish. The Wine News, 91 Points

**Pillot Chassagne Montrachet "Les Chaumes" 2005 \$49.99/\$599.88**

A complex and pungent nose of herb, resin, earth and freshly squeezed lemon juice merges into rich, full and intense flavors that offer plenty of personality and character if not elegance, all wrapped in a finish brimming with dry extract on the agreeably long finish. Solid. Burghound, 88 points

**Autard Chateaneuf du Pape 2006 \$29.99/\$359.88**

Delivers a nice beam of raspberry, graphite and sweet earth notes, backed by a toasty, slightly firm finish. Should round out nicely with modest cellaring. Best from 2009 through 2018. Wine Spectator, 90 points.

**Gilles Ferran Cotes du Rhone "Les Sabillieres: 2007 \$12.99/\$140.00**

This is a blend of 70% Grenache, 20% Syrah, and 10% Carignan. It has a dark ruby color with glints of violet, and shows pure fruit flavors of raspberries with a touch of dark, moist earth. It is delightful drinking, not too complex, with the weight of a Beaujolais. Los Angeles Times, Best Buy

**Cuvee Stephi Grenache/Syrah 2007 \$11.99/\$129.00**

This is a 65%/35% blend from Roussillon in France on the hill-sides of the Pyrenees right by the Mediterranean. The grapes are harvested from 15 to 45 year old vines which make for a rich, intense wine with an opulent nose of ripe red berries, a smooth full mouth feel, and a soft, spicy, lingering finish.

**Cuvee Stephi Chardonnay 2008 \$11.99/\$129.00**

This wine of 100% unoaked Chardonnay is made from the grapes grown in the Languedoc. The vines are nourished by silt and sand subsoil, which makes the wine very rich and long on the palate with a refreshing finish. It is a delightful wine, very expressive of white flowers and lemon with spicy notes.

**Domaine de Ballade Cotes de Gascone 2008 \$8.99/\$97.00**

This lovely blend of 70 percent Sauvignon Blanc and 30 percent Colombard is fresh and lively with an incredible balance between minerality and acidity. The nose is fresh with fragrances of lemon and white flowers, and its flavor profile is dominated by citrus notes, crisp acidity, and a zesty, clean finish.

**Domaine des Florets Gigondas 2007 \$29.99/\$323.00**

A blend of Grenache 80%, Syrah 10%, Mourvèdre 5%, Cinsault 5%, this wine is made from older vines with an average age of 60 years. The harvest is picked and sorted by hand at prime maturity. Grenache brings the strength, fat and softness, the Syrah brings elegance and fruit, the Mourvèdre brings the backbone, and the Cinsault the sweetness.

**Thevenot Cotes de Nuits "Les Renardes" 2006 \$19.99/\$215.00**

The nose combines the black fruit aromas of blackcurrant and blackberry with subtle spicy notes. The structure is firm now but will lighten into a beautiful smoothness and a long finish. The tannins are silky and the flavors become more complex upon aeration with notes of underbrush and game.

## *Churchill's Estate Douro Red 2007* \$17.99/\$215.88

This wine is produced from traditional Port grape varieties: Touriga Nacional, Touriga Francesa, Tinta Roriz, Tinta Barroca, and Tinta Cao. On the nose there are complex and distinctive fresh fruit and floral aromas with discreet spice and pepper wood notes. On the palate is good acidity with rich, spicy, red fruit flavors. It has a balanced character with soft tannins that lead to an elegant and long finish.
